

Professional Governance Act Transition | Repealed and Replaced Documents

The AIBC transitioned to the *Professional Governance Act* (PGA) on February 10, 2023. Part of the legislative transition resulted in the repeal of several AIBC regulatory documents, as they became obsolete or replaced under the PGA, *Architects Regulation* or AIBC Bylaws.

Below are several charts showing which documents have been repealed, and where to find the updated material. Almost all information can be found in the new <u>AIBC Bylaws and attached Schedules</u>.
